WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City has been designated a Tree City USA for the thirty ninth (39th) consecutive year by the National Arbor Day Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City believes in the value and preservation of trees and funds a tree maintenance program for publicly-owned trees and administers a tree preservation ordinance to protect privately-owned trees to ensure a legacy of mature trees within the community; and
