

RESOLUTION NO. 16041

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY AND WAGE PLAN FOR CLASSIFICATIONS REPRESENTED BY THE SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION LOCAL 521, AND FOR THE CLASSIFICATION OF LANDSCAPE SUPERVISOR

WHEREAS, the City and the Service Employees International Union Local 521 (“SEIU”) have reached agreement on a Successor Memorandum of Understanding for February 1, 2022 – January 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the parties agreed to amend the classification and salary and wage plan by granting a 3% cost-of-living adjustment effective February 14, 2022, a 3% cost-of-living adjustment effective February 13, 2023, and a 3% cost-of-living adjustment effective February 12, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City and Redwood City Management Employees Association have met and conferred and reached agreement on amended salary range for the classification of Landscape Supervisor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City’s salary and wage plan for SEIU classifications will be amended as set forth in Exhibit A-1, A-2, A-3, and Exhibit C.
2. The salary and wage plan for the classification of Landscape Supervisor will be amended as set forth in Exhibit B, and Exhibit C.
3. This resolution shall be effective upon the date of its adoption.
