2. Adopt a resolution amending the City's Classification and Salary and Wage Plan for classifications represented by COA and IAFF; and
3. Adopt a resolution appropriating and transferring certain funds for increased salary and benefits costs related to the COA and IAFF successor Memorandum of Understandings that begin in Fiscal Year 2021-2022.
