

**RESOLUTION NO. 16051**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY  
ADOPTING THE SEWER SERVICE CHARGES REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR  
2022-23 AND AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF SEWER SERVICE  
CHARGES ON THE TAX ROLL**

**WHEREAS**, on June 24, 2019, the City Council of the City of Redwood City ("City") adopted Ordinance No. 2464, which established and levied sewer service charges upon each premises or any portion thereof that receives or uses sewerage service from the City's sewerage facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the sewer service charges were adopted in compliance with Article XIID, Section 6 of the California Constitution, Government Code section 53750 et seq., and Health and Safety Code section 5471; and

**WHEREAS**, the City currently imposes the sewer service charges, set by Ordinance No. 2464, on a monthly basis by directly billing its sewer customers; and

**WHEREAS**, the City would like to begin imposing the previously adopted sewer service charges on Residential Customers with one (1) dwelling unit on an annual basis by collecting the sewer service charges for those customers on the tax roll pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 5473 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the City prepared a written report for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 ("Report"), which contains a description of each parcel of real property, containing a Residential Customer with one (1) dwelling unit, that receives sewerage services from the City's sewerage facilities and the amount of the sewer service charge for each of those parcels for the Fiscal Year, computed in conformity with the sewer service charges set by Ordinance No. 2464; and

**WHEREAS**, the Report is on file with the City Clerk and available to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the Report provides that the sewer service charges for each parcel listed in the Report will be \$1,071.36 for Fiscal Year 2022-2023; and

**WHEREAS**, at its meeting on June 13, 2022, after duly publishing and posting all required notices, the City Council held a public hearing as part of a regularly scheduled meeting to consider the Report and heard all objections or protests to the Report, if any.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The recitals set forth above are true and correct, and are hereby incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** The City Council finds and determines that notice of the filing of the Report and of the time and place of the hearing thereon was mailed and published in accordance with Health and Safety Code Sections 5473.1.

**Section 3.** After hearing and considering all objections or protests to the Report, if any, the City Council finds that protest was not made by a majority of the separate parcels of property described in the Report and hereby adopts the Report.

**Section 4.** The sewer service charges listed in the Report shall be collected on the tax roll in the same manner, by the same persons, and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, the general taxes for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

**Section 5.** The County Controller of the County of San Mateo is hereby authorized to collect the sewer service charges listed in the Report on the tax roll.

**Section 6.** This resolution shall take effect immediately.

The City of Redwood City is considering whether to collect charges for its sewerage services provided to residential customers with one dwelling unit on the tax roll. City staff prepared a report for Fiscal Year 2022-2023, which includes a description of each parcel of real property containing one residential dwelling unit and receiving sewerage services from the City and the sewer service charges for each of those parcels for the year. This report is on file with the City Clerk and available to the public. You are hereby notified that, on June 13, 2022, at 6:00pm PST, the City Council will hold a public hearing to consider whether to adopt the report and elect to have such charges collected on the tax roll in the same manner, by the same persons, and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, its general taxes. At the public hearing, the Council shall hear and consider all objections or protests to the report. If the Council finds that protest is made by the owners of a majority of the affected parcels, then the report will not be adopted and the charges will not be collected on the tax roll. If you would like to participate in the public hearing, you may do so by attending in person or using the Zoom Teleconference information provided above. While the City anticipates that the public hearing will be conducted in-person at the City Council Chambers and over Zoom, if the City Council cannot hold the hearing in-person due to conditions relating to COVID-19, then the hearing may be conducted solely over Zoom. Anyone wishing to attend the hearing should confirm the location by reviewing the Agenda for the June 13, 2022 City Council Meeting, which shall be published 72 hours prior to the meeting.
