

RESOLUTION NO. 16057

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION; AND REQUESTING COUNTY TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO CITY; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY FOR SUCH SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redwood City called a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of electing three (3) full time Members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City the precincts, polling places and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the County Election Department of the County of San Mateo canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, in order to perform such service, the County requires that the City enter into a contract specifying the services to be performed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AS FOLLOWS:

1. That pursuant to the requirements of California Election Code § 10403, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of electing three (3) City Council Members for the term of office of four years each; and that the County Election Department is requested to render services to the City related to the conduct of the election.
2. That the consolidated election will be held and conducted in a manner prescribed in California Election Code § 10418.
3. That pursuant to California Election Code § 10002, the City requests that the Board of Supervisors permit the County Elections official to render services as specified in the County Services Agreement relating to the conduct of the election.

4. That the San Mateo County Elections Department is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.
5. That the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Elections Official to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.
6. That the City of Redwood City recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County of San Mateo by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County of San Mateo for any costs.
7. That the City Clerk of the City of Redwood City is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the county election department of the County of San Mateo.
8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
9. That the City Clerk is authorized to execute that certain Agreement entitled "Services Agreement for the Provisions of Election Services between the City of Redwood City and the San Mateo County Chief Elections Officer & Assessor – County Clerk – Recorder" (the "Services Agreement") for the performance by the County Clerk of the County of San Mateo of certain services pertaining to the Statewide General Election to be held on November 8, 2022. Furthermore, the City Manager is authorized to make adjustments to the Services Agreement in the event that changes would be beneficial to the City.
