Meeting of the Joint City Council/Successor Agency Board/Public Financing Authority Meeting on July 25, 2022.

Present: Espinoza-Garnica, Gee, Howard, Reddy, Smith and Mayor Hale.

Motion and second, Smith and Espinoza-Garnica, to approve and authorize the City Manager to sign Amendment No. 4 to the Agreement for Services between the City of Redwood City and Downtown Streets, Inc. to increase compensation by six hundred thousand one hundred forty four dollars (\$600,144) for a total not-to-exceed amount of one million seven hundred ninety seven thousand six hundred sixteen dollars (\$1,797,616) to extend to a fourth year the program that provides volunteer work experience for people experiencing homelessness while contributing to beautification, clean-up projects, and homeless outreach efforts for the City.

Motion passes 6-0-1 by roll call vote, with Council Member Aguirre absent.
