

RESOLUTION NO. 16071

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT WITH PUBLIC RISK INNOVATION SOLUTIONS, AND MANAGEMENT EFFECTIVE FOR JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023 TO COVER LOSSES THAT EXCEED \$350,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE EXCESS INSURANCE PREMIUM PAYMENT IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City is self-insured for workers' compensation;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City has excess insurance coverage through Public Risk Innovation, Solutions, and Management for claims that exceed costs over \$350,000; and

WHEREAS, the upcoming excess insurance policy agreement is for July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City's FY 2022-23 estimated excess insurance premium is estimated to be \$750,000; and

WHEREAS, funding is included in the FY 2022-23 Adopted Budget in the Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to renew the excess insurance agreement for FY 2022-23 and to approve payment to Public Risk Innovation, Solutions, and Management for insurance premium not to exceed \$750,000.
