

RESOLUTION NO. 16075

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY APPOINTING A MEMBER TO FILL THE CITY COUNCIL SEAT FOR DISTRICT 4 PURSUANT TO REDWOOD CITY CHARTER SECTION 9

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2020, Michael Smith was elected to the City Council of the City of Redwood City by the voters in District 4, and his term is due to expire in December 2024; and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2022, Councilmember Smith submitted a letter to the City Clerk announcing his intent to resign from the City Council effective August 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9 of the City Charter, after such vacancy occurs, the remaining Councilmembers shall appoint someone to fill the vacancy until the next general municipal election within sixty (60) days; and

WHEREAS, under Election Code section 21626, in filling the vacancy, the boundaries of District 4 , which were in effect at the time of Councilmember Smith's election in 2020, control; and

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2022, the City Council directed that the City initiate an application process for appointing an eligible successor to fill the District 4 City Council seat for the remainder of the term; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited applications from eligible residents in District 4 and these eligible candidates were interviewed by the City Council at the regular meeting on this August 22, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on this August 22, 2022, the City Council considered the appointment of a candidate to serve the remainder of said term, which expires in December 2024 when a newly elected representative of District 4 is elected and sworn in to fill a new four-year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY THAT:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are true and correct and shall be the findings of City of Redwood City Council.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 9 of the City Charter, Elmer Martinez Saballos is appointed as a member of City Council of Redwood City for District 4.

SECTION 3. The person appointed as set forth in this Resolution shall take office and be sworn-in at the regular meeting on this August 22, 2022 and shall serve on the City Council until the person who is elected by District 4 voters at the November 5, 2024 general municipal election has been sworn in to serve on the City of Redwood City Council for District 4 for a new four-year term.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
