

**RESOLUTION NO. 16092**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION AMENDMENT TO FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 PARKS IMPACT FEES FUND TO INCREASE EXPENDITURES BY \$576,976.40 FOR THE DOLPHIN PARK PLAYGROUND RENOVATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Dolphin Park playground and the surrounding surfacing needs a complete renovation; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2021, staff and Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commissioners hosted an open-house at Dolphin Park to gather direct input from neighbors and park visitors about what they would like to see in a renovation (the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to appropriate available and unencumbered Parks Impact Fees for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 to accommodate completion of the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct, are hereby incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth in their entirety, and constitute findings in this matter.
2. The Parks Impact Fee Fund – Dolphin Park Playground Renovation expenditure budget shall be increased by \$576,976.40 equal to 10% of the awarded contract amount.
3. The resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
