A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR SPECIFIED GRANT FUNDS FROM THE BUDGET ACT OF 2022, ITEM 3790-101-0001 AS AMENDED BY AB 179, SECTION 19.56 ITEM# (b)(13)(D) \$4,450,000 TO THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY TO ASSIST WITH FUNDING CONVERSION OF LIBRARY LOT A AND THE MAIN STREET/CITY HALL REDWOOD CITY PARKING LOTS TO ACTIVE PARK SPACES, THE CREATION OF THE REDWOOD CREEK TRAIL VIA NEW BOARDWALKS, AND PROVIDE INITIAL FUNDING FOR TAFT SCHOOL FIELD IMPROVEMENTS (COLLECTIVELY, "THE PROJECTS")

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility by the Legislature of the State of California for the administration of a grant to the City of Redwood City, setting up necessary procedures governing application(s); and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant's Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of project application(s) before submission of said applications to the State; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will enter into a contract with the State of California to complete the Projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY:

1. The City Council of the City of Redwood City (City Council) hereby approves the filing of the project applications for the specified grant Projects.
2. The City Council certifies that said applicant has or will have available, prior to commencement of project work utilizing specified grant funds, sufficient funds, including those provided by this grant, to complete the Projects.
3. The City Council certifies that the applicant has or will provide sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Projects.
4. The City Council certifies that the applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees to the Provisions contained in the contract in this Procedural Guide.

5. The City Council delegates the authority to the City Manager, or designee to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project scopes.

6. The Council agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and guidelines.

7. This Resolution will be effective upon adoption.
