Motion and second, Aguirre and Martinez Saballos, to approve and authorize the City Manager to execute the following Agreements for Services:

1. Agreement for on-call services with ALTA for a three-year term in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, with the City Manager authorized to extend the agreement for two additional one-year periods in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 per year;
2. Agreement for on-call services with Fehr & Peers for a three-year term in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, with the City Manager authorized to extend the agreement for two additional one-year periods in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 per year;
3. Agreement for on-call services with Schaaf & Wheeler for a three-year term in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, with the City Manager authorized to extend the agreement for two additional one-year periods in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 per year;
4. Agreement for on-call services with TDG Engineering, Inc. for a three-year term in an amount not to exceed \$325,000, with the City Manager authorized to extend the agreement for two additional one-year periods in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 per year; and
5. Agreement for on-call services with V. W. Housen for a three-year term in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, with the City Manager authorized to extend the agreement for two additional one-year periods in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 per year.
