

**RESOLUTION NO. 16141**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY GRANTING CONSENT TO THE CITY OF BURLINGAME TO INCLUDE AREAS UNDER THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY IN THE PROPOSED SAN FRANCISCO PENINSULA TOURISM MARKETING DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County Tourism Business Improvement District (the "TBID") was established by the City of Burlingame ("Burlingame") in 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, by its Resolution No. 14106, adopted on December 18, 2000, the City Council of the City of Redwood City ("Redwood City") granted consent to Burlingame to include Redwood City within the boundaries of the TBID; and

**WHEREAS**, an assessment is levied in connection with the TBID upon commercial lodging facilities in Redwood City and throughout San Mateo County to fund activities that promote tourism; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2023, the City Council of Burlingame adopted a resolution declaring its intention to establish the San Francisco Peninsula Tourism Marketing District (the "TMD"), pursuant to the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994 (Streets and Highways Code § 36600 *et seq*); and

**WHEREAS**, in connection with the TMD an assessment would be levied at a rate of 1.5% of gross short-term sleeping room rental revenue for lodging businesses with 5,000 square feet or more of dedicated meeting space, and 0.75% for all other lodging businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, stays of more than thirty (30) consecutive days; certain stays provided to airline cockpit and/or cabin crews pursuant to an agreement between a hotel and an airline; and certain stays by federal or state government employees or officers or employees of a foreign government would be excluded from assessment; and

**WHEREAS**, as more completely described in the Management District Plan governing the TMD, assessments proceeds would be used to fund sales and marketing programs to market assessed lodging businesses as tourist, meeting, and event destinations; and

**WHEREAS**, if established, the TMD would replace the TBID; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County/Silicon Valley Convention and Visitors Bureau dba The San Francisco Peninsula would serve as Owners' Association for the TMD;

**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2023, the City Council of Burlingame adopted a resolution requesting consent of the Cities of Belmont, Brisbane, East Palo Alto, Foster City, Half Moon Bay, Menlo Park, Millbrae, Pacifica, Redwood City, San Bruno, San Carlos, San Mateo, and South San Francisco to include their territory within the TMD and requesting the consent of San Mateo County to include its unincorporated territory within the TMD; and

**WHEREAS**, without the consent of the City Council of Redwood City, Burlingame cannot include in the TMD any territory within the jurisdiction of Redwood City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Redwood City desires to grant the requested consent.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, THAT:**

**Section 1:** The above recitals are true and correct.

**Section 2:** Pursuant to Section 36620.5 of the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994, the City Council hereby grants consent to the City of Burlingame to include all of the territory of the City of Redwood City within the TMD.

**Section 3:** The TMD would be a program of the City of Burlingame and assessments levied in connection with the TMD would be levied and approved by the City of Burlingame. Nothing in this Resolution shall be construed as an acceptance by the City of Redwood City of any responsibility for levying or collecting any assessment in connection with the TMD or for the use of assessment proceeds.

**Section 4:** The City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the City Clerk of the City of Burlingame.

**Section 5:** This Resolution is effective upon its adoption.
