

**RESOLUTION NO. 16035**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY INCREASING SPECIAL GAS TAX STREET IMPROVEMENT FUND – ROADWAY PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM BUDGETED EXPENDITURES BY \$873,989 AND THE MEASURE W FUND – ROADWAY PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM BUDGETED EXPENDITURES BY \$1,158,200 TO ALLOCATE RECEIVED REVENUE TO THE 2021 OVERLAY PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, during the course of a fiscal year, the City Council may take actions that change or modify the City of Redwood City's (the "City") existing and approved budgets; and

**WHEREAS**, a Dirt Hauling Fee is levied on construction projects which haul materials on City streets to offset the damage construction vehicles impose; and

**WHEREAS**, revenues collected from the Dirt Hauling Fee need to be allocated to roadway pavement projects from time to time in order to use those funds to maintain City streets; and

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into an agreement with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority to receive its distribution of Measure W funds for local transportation purposes in accordance with the San Mateo County Congestion Relief Plan, effective July 1, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Congestion Relief Plan includes an annual allocation of 12.5% of the total revenue generated by the Transactions and Use Tax for the Local Safety, Pothole & Congestion Relief Improvements Program Category, of which 10% will be allocated annually to the County of San Mateo (County) and the cities of the County (Tax Proceeds) for eligible investments; and

**WHEREAS**, appropriations need to be established in order for staff to utilize revenues received; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to transfer funding in order to facilitate construction of the 2021 Overlay Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby incorporated by this reference as if fully set forth in their entirety.
2. *Special Gas Tax Street Improvement Fund – Roadway Pavement Management Program* budgeted expenditures shall be increased by \$873,989.
3. *Measure W Fund - Roadway Pavement Management Program* budgeted expenditure shall be increased by \$1,158,200.
4. The resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
