## Recognizing Long-Serving Planning Commissioner Nancy Radcliffe

**WHEREAS**, Nancy Radcliffe was first appointed to the Redwood City Planning Commission in October, 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, Nancy Radcliffe continued to serve five additional consecutive terms over the next 20 years; and

**WHEREAS**, Nancy Radcliffe also headed the Planning Commission as its Chairperson for several years during her tenure; and

**WHEREAS**, Chair Radcliffe was an instrumental voice in the Commission's work related to the adoption of the affordable housing ordinance, and key affordable housing projects such as Arroyo Green Apartments, Habitat for Humanity, 353 Main, and 1304 ECR were approved during her tenure; and


**WHEREAS**, Chair Radcliffe was also involved in many of the City's pivotal projects such as the Downtown Parks and Bay Connectivity Plan, Housing Element, Gatekeeper Project, Transit District, Accessory Dwelling Units, and Residential Design Guidelines and was serving on the Planning Commission when the City adopted the Downtown Precise Plan; and


**WHEREAS**, in her decades of experience on the Planning Commission, Chair Radcliffe has upheld the Commission's charge to strive for the best interest of the City of Redwood City and to evaluate all proposals as to the best interest of the entire community, and has greatly contributed to the successful projects that continue to benefit the Redwood City community today.


