

RESOLUTION NO 16113

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PAY TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 ASSESSMENT FOR ADMINISTERING THE STATE'S WORKERS' COMPENSATION PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$124,305.79

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City is self-insured for workers' compensation;
and

WHEREAS, California Labor Code Sections 62.5 and 62.6 authorizes the State of California Department of Industrial Relations to assess fees to employers for costs of administering the State's workers' compensation program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City is assessed every year by the Department of Industrial Relations to support the State program; and

WHEREAS, for FY 2022-23, the City's share of assessments authorized by Labor Code Sections 62.5 and 62.6 is \$124,305.79.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager is authorized to pay the State of California Department of Industrial Relations invoice setting forth the FY 2022-23 assessment of \$124,305.79.
2. This resolution is effective upon its adoption.
