A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING CERTAIN FUNDS FOR INCREASED SALARY AND BENEFIT COSTS RELATED TO THE REDWOOD CITY MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION SUCCESSOR MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING THAT BEGINS IN FY 2021-2022

WHEREAS, during the course of a fiscal year, the City Council may take actions that change or modify the City’s existing and approved budgets; and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been reached with the Redwood City Management Employees Association (“RCMEA”) on a Successor Memorandum of Understanding for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2024 that requires increased budgets in all of funds that have RCMEA salary and benefits costs, as detailed below.
