

**RESOLUTION NO 16121**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES (DWR) AND SUBMISSION OF ANY DOCUMENTS AND REPORTS REQUIRED, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF TWO (2) FOUR MILLION-GALLON DRINKING WATER TANKS AT SEQUOIA WATER STATION, UNDER THE DWR 2022 URBAN COMMUNITY DROUGHT RELIEF PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, funding for the Department of Water Resources (DWR) 2022 Urban Community Drought Relief Program was authorized by the State Legislature; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Redwood City (City) has the legal authority and is authorized to enter into a funding agreement with the State of California; and

**WHEREAS**, the City proposes to implement the project titled Sequoia Tanks Replacement Project, for the replacement of two (2) concrete drinking water tanks at Sequoia Water Station (Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the City intends to apply for grant funding from the DWR for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the DWR provides funding to cover up to 75% of the Project cost and requires the applicant to provide a minimum commitment of 25% for the local share of the Project cost; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project cost is estimated to be approximately \$15.4 Million; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's matching funds commitment is 25%, or \$3.85 Million; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to obtain DWR grant funding for the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That pursuant and subject to all of the terms and provisions of Budget Act of 2021 (Stats. 2021, ch. 240, § 80) as amended (Stats. 2022, ch. 44, § 25), the City Manager of Redwood City, or designee is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application for funding with the DWR and take such other actions necessary or appropriate to obtain grant funding.

2. The City Manager of Redwood City, or designee is hereby authorized and directed to submit any required documents, invoices, and reports required to obtain grant funding.

3. The resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
