

RESOLUTION NO 16122

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES (DWR) AND SUBMISSION OF ANY DOCUMENTS, AND REPORTS REQUIRED, FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE RECYCLED WATER DISTRIBUTION PIPELINE WITH ASSOCIATED STORAGE AND BOOSTER PUMP FACILITIES, UNDER THE DWR 2022 URBAN COMMUNITY DROUGHT RELIEF PROGRAM

WHEREAS, funding for the Department of Water Resources (DWR) 2022 Urban Community Drought Relief Program was authorized by the State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redwood City (City) has the legal authority and is authorized to enter into a funding agreement with the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to implement the Expansion of the Recycled Water Distribution Pipeline with Associated Storage and Booster Pump Facilities Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the City intends to apply for grant funding from the DWR for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the DWR provides funding to cover up to 75% of the Project cost and requires the applicant to provide a minimum matching funds commitment of 25% for the local share of the Project cost; and

WHEREAS, the Project cost is estimated to be approximately \$29.7 Million; and

WHEREAS, the City's matching funds commitment is 25%, or \$7.43 Million; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain DWR grant funding for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That pursuant and subject to all of the terms and provisions of Budget Act of 2021 (Stats. 2021, Ch. 240, § 80) as amended (Stats. 2022, Ch. 44, § 25), the City Manager of Redwood City, or designee is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application for funding with the Department of Water Resources and take such other actions necessary or appropriate to obtain grant funding.

2. The City Manager of Redwood City, or designee is hereby authorized and directed to submit any required documents, invoices, and reports required to obtain grant funding.

3. The resolution shall be effective upon adoption.


