## **IN RECOGNITION OF THE RETIREMENT OF NOTRE DAME DE NAMUR UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT JUDITH MAXWELL GREIG**

***WHEREAS**, the City of Redwood City recognizes the distinguished career, service and leadership of Notre Dame de Namur University President Judith Maxwell Greig; and*

***WHEREAS**, her 31-year commitment as part of Notre Dame de Namur University, whether as a member of faculty, senior advisor, dean, provost, trustee and finally as president, President Greig's outstanding legacy will leave an impact on higher education and the community; and*
