

RESOLUTION NO. 16197

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY 1) ACCEPTING FY 2022 FEMA'S ASSISTANCE TO FIRE FIGHTERS GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,320,577.55 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED GRANT AGREEMENT, SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS OR MODIFICATIONS, AND OTHER RELATED DOCUMENTS; 2) APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION AMENDMENT TO INCREASE THE FY2023-24 GENERAL FUND REVENUE BY \$1,320,577.55; AND 3) APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A THREE-YEAR COMMUNICATIONS PRODUCTS AGREEMENT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,446,572 TO PURCHASE COMMUNICATIONS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2023, the City of Redwood City was awarded the FY 2022 FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Grant in the amount of \$1,320,577.55; and

WHEREAS, the AFG grant allows the City to purchase tri-band (VHF, UHF, 700/800 MHz) P-25 compliant, digital trunking capable mobile and portable radios for all frontline and ready-reserve vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to accept the grant, authorize the City Manager to execute any required grant agreement, subsequent amendments or modifications, and other related documents, and transfer funding in order to facilitate the purchase; and

WHEREAS, during the course of a fiscal year, the City Council may take actions that change or modify the City's existing and approved budgets; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Budget is required for grant revenue to be received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby accepts the FY 2022 FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) Award in the amount of \$1,320,577.55; and authorizes the City Manager to execute any required grant agreement, subsequent amendments or modifications, and other related documents.

Section 2. The following stated amounts, as set forth below, are hereby transferred to account for revenue associated with the FEMA AFG Award and the Motorola contract.

Section 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

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
