

**RESOLUTION NO. 16198**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 REPORT OF COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 13146.4 RELATING TO MANDATORY FIRE INSPECTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, in 2018 the California State Legislature adopted SB 1205, pertaining to compliance reporting of mandatory inspections pursuant to California Health and Safety Code ("Health and Safety Code") Sections 13146.2 and 12146.3; and

**WHEREAS**, Health and Safety Code Section 13146.2 requires the Redwood City Fire Department ("Fire Department") to perform annual inspections of all hotels, motels, apartment houses, buildings, and structures accessory thereto within its jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, Health and Safety Code Section 13146.3 requires the Fire Department to perform annual inspections on every building used as a public or private school within its jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4, the Fire Department is now required to annually report compliance with Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 12146.3 to its administering authority; and

**WHEREAS**, Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4 defines an administering authority as a city council, county board of supervisors, or district board, as the case may be; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Department reported its FY 22/23 compliance with Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 to the City Council of the City of Redwood City.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth in their entirety.
2. The City Council of the City of Redwood City acknowledges receipt of the mandatory reporting on compliance with Healthy and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 for Fiscal Year 22/23, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, as is required by Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4.
3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.


