I am a Redwood City resident (94061) urging you to reject attempts to adopt divisive resolutions about the Israel-Hamas War.

As antisemitism and Islamophobia continue to escalate in the Bay Area, the introduction of one-sided resolutions about the Israel-Hamas War will only further inflame tensions between already-traumatized Muslim and Jewish communities and create a forum for hate, which has already been evidenced in nearby cities and in my own experience as a graduate student at Stanford.

Mayor London Breed released a statement about on the San Francisco City Council meeting during which a ceasefire resolution was decided upon. Her statement shared "numerous Jewish San Franciscans who tell [her] they don't feel safe in their own City." She astutely and accurately reported that the movement for local governments to adopt ceasefire resolutions for a country and international war outside their purview, stating "our City has been angrier, more divided, and less safe. Sadly, that may have been the point. Their exercise was never about bringing people together; it was about choosing a side." Local government ceasefire resolutions are inappropriate, show a serious lack of focus on local needs and issues of our community, of which there are many, and pit two minority groups against each other: Jews versus Arabs, Israeli-Redwood City residents versus Palestinian-Redwood City residents. Both of our communities are hurting.

I am a graduate student at Stanford, and I have a Palestinian friend and labmate. We check in on each other, ask about our families in Israel/Palestine, and hug each other when we cry over the hurt, grief, and fear of the past few months. I have an Iranian friend with loved ones in Gaza. He is terrified for his friends, and we talk about whether our loved ones are safe. These friends and I show compassion to each other and have not stopped caring about each other; this compassion that I have NOT experienced shared by the non-Jewish, non-Israeli, non-Arab, non-Palestinian people putting forth these resolutions and parroting statements about a strip they had never heard of prior to October 2023. People directly hurt by this conflict can talk to each other with care and compassion. Those unaffected by this conflict are forcing forth hateful, one-sided resolutions and them and those who scream out in support of them cannot show this compassion, and that lack of compassion is what is bringing this proposal into Redwood City today—people want to take the opportunity to express antisemitic beliefs and hateful rhetoric against Jews and Israelis, and want to show they only have compassion for one side.

Finally, Mayor London Breed reported on the horrific anti-Jewish hate and stereotyping in the San Francisco City Council Chamber, hate that I predict is entering the Redwood City Council Chamber tonight, which is why I am not attending in person. Mayor Breed reported "People in the crowd made pig noises, devil horns

with their hands, and screamed for him [a Jewish speaker] to 'kill himself' as he walked out the chamber." I experienced more subtle, but still present, perpetuation of antisemitic tropes at a similar meeting of the Stanford Graduate Workers Union, who adopted a statement on Palestine in October 2023, and ignored and silenced Jewish and Israeli students who tried to attend a meeting to work with the union. I submitted a public comment specifically about that incident at the City Council meeting last month. I am genuinely too stressed, nervous, and afraid to attend a council meeting in my own city after these experiences.

A resolution taking sides in a war between two other countries is far beyond the scope of your duties. As a Redwood City resident and fellow liberal voter, I urge you to please continue to focus on local priorities and to promote opportunities that bring our diverse population together not divide us. **Please let this cease-fire resolution end here and not move forward for a vote.**
